It's Never Too Late to Become a Great Dad

Focus on the Family's Jim Daly with encouraging words for Fathers.

Daly grew up in a dysfunctional family and bounced through the foster care system. Today, Daly is President and CEO of Focus on the Family. His first book, *Finding Home*, detailed his difficult childhood. His latest book, *The Good Dad: Becoming the Father You Were Meant to Be*, shows that a rough upbringing need not ruin one's ambitions of leading a healthy family.

Daly states that his upbringing has shined a big spotlight on the crucial importance of having—and being—a good dad. Because he never had a positive male role model in his life, he understands the value of an involved father in a way that many of his friends couldn't grasp. Daly believes with all his heart that to be in Christ is to be a new creature (2 Corinthians 5:17). This suggests that followers of Jesus are not defined by their past. They don't have to be locked into or held down by the sins of their fathers. Christ has set them free from slavery to the "same old, same old" of previous generations. **In God, all things are possible.** Daly's mission is to let people know that **Jesus came to redeem us and to heal us.**

God expects fathers to provide for his family. This enables a mother to devote time to the love, care, and raising the children with his full support. This is his God-given duty. ~ 1 Timothy 5:8

Fathers are required to discipline their children—training, teaching, encouraging and correcting. ~ Hebrews 12:5-11

What a challenging standard God sets for husbands and fathers! Look to Him to give you the strength! You will be an honored father.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, thank you for your faithfulness. And bless all the fathers we honor on this day. Give them strength, courage and wisdom. Help them to be a rock & fortress for their children. Amen.

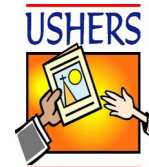
