Outreach Prayers

The Calvary Outreach team is going to be intentional about providing you, the congregation, with updates on the ministries you support. Our vision is that this space will be a source of ministry updates, prayer requests and testimonies from those serving in their mission fields. We hope to share what is going on in their lives so that we can be more connected to them rather than one update a year during their Mission of the Month presentations.

Pink House is a ministry of InterVarsity Christian Fellowship at NDSU. Calvary is invited to serve Friday evening meals to the students one time a month. Average attendance for these meals is 110 students.

Collette Michael shares this: Students returned from Urbana (a collegiate student missions conference sponsored by InterVarsity) eager to pursue God and join Him in mission on campus—with greater depth, focus and vision. One grad student wrote: "I got to hear testimonies from experts who have stayed true to their faith and spread the love of God through their profession, no matter what the world or their professions may demand. This was one of the reasons I attended Urbana15, and I can now boldly say, I know how I can fit in and use my story to spread the gospel to the world career-wise, spiritually, financially and socially." Pray that students will faithfully live out the ministry commitments they made while at the conference.

Pray for the grad student leadership team as they apply to be an officially recognized student group at NDSU-InterVarsity Grad Christian Fellowship International.

Ask God to bring us 10 missional Christian grad students (American & International) to add to our current core of 5. These will be the students who plan chapter events and lead Bible studies, group activities and outreach.
