Outreach of the Month



As we began learning on March 6th, Open Doors 65 is a Christ centered ministry to help Fargo-Moorhead area individuals and families experiencing financial difficulties, homelessness, or the need for a caring community.

On October 25, 2012 a one night survey was taken of men and women in emergency shelters, battered women's shelters, and transitional housing programs as well as non-shelter locations in Fargo and Moorhead. The survey found that 458 people (211 men, 129 women, and 118 children) were residing in temporary housing programs. The survey also identified 416 persons in informal and unsheltered locations, including the partners (43) and children (33) of the survey respondents. The total homeless population identified was 874 persons (624 in Fargo and 250 in Moorhead).

Our homeless population is disproportionately people of color (particularly Native Americans). While less than 10% of ND and 15% of MN overall population is made of up people of color over 3 in 10 homeless adults in Fargo-Moorhead are persons of color.

On the date of the survey Military Veterans made up one-quarter of all homeless persons in Fargo and about 10% in Moorhead.

These are the people that Open Doors 65 is dedicated to serving by providing a free thrift store, a place to gather, fellowship, prayer, Bible Studies, coffee, tea, and doughnuts.

We can help by praying, volunteering in the store, greeting guests, and by donating much needed items like: bedding, shoes, socks, undergarments, bathroom supplies (towels, wash cloths, toothbrushes etc.) men's clothing, small appliances, or anything you'd like when setting up a new home! They are also in need of Bibles, used or new in any translation. A lot of immigrant families are being served so Bibles in different languages are welcomed also.

Our love offering today will go toward paying rent for Open Doors 65.
