Outreach

Because of a motel shortage in Boscobel Wisconsin the fall of 1898 two strangers were forced to share a motel room. That night they discovered that both of them were Christian. During their evening devotion as they prayed together an idea began to form. A few months later they met together with another Christian and concluded that they would "band Christian travelers together for mutual recognition, personal evangelism, and united service for the Lord." From the meeting the Gideons were born.

Since most of the member in the early years were traveling men, the question arose of how to most effectively evangelize at the motels where they stayed. One member suggested that they supply a Bible for each motel room. This would not only encourage each of their members but would potentially bless all travelers. This plan, which they called "The Bible Project" was adopted at Louisville, Kentucky, in 1908.

It's been over 100 years since The Gideons International placed the first Bible in a hotel room in Montana. Today, Gideons are organized in more than 190 countries around the globe. Bibles and New Testaments are printed for distribution by The Gideons International in more than 90 languages. Through God's grace and to His Glory, more than 1.9 billion Bibles and New Testaments have been placed through their association, and the work continues.

Pray for continued success of the Gideons in places they are already established and for opportunities to witness in new places, for vibrancy of members and a desire for others to join them in their mission. Pray for the people of Calvary to continue developing a heart for evangelism and a desire to share Christ with all those we have contact with at work, at home, and in the community.
