Outreach Prayer

UMCOR

At General Conference in 1940 UMCOR’s forerunner (Methodist Committee for Overseas Relief) was described by Bishop Herbert Welch as, “voice of conscience among Methodists to act in the relief of human suffering without distinction of race, color, or creed.” The initial goal was to respond to suffering among peoples overseas after the onset of World War II.

That first committee was to be temporary but General Conference reapproved its work every four years until 1972 when the United Methodist Committee on Relief was made a permanent part of the General Board of Global Ministries.

Since then UMCOR has provided aid to people in 80 countries, including the United States. They provide humanitarian relief when war, conflict, or natural disaster disrupt life to such an extent that communities are unable to recover on their own.



UMCOR is not a first response team, rather UMCOR cooperates with other aid organizations to extend their reach. When initial response teams are gone UMCOR comes in to provide solutions to emergency or chronic conditions beginning with the affected population. UMCOR’s most important partners are the people they serve, they provide these survivors not only temporary relief but long-term education, training, and support.

Sunday May 29 we will receive an offering for UMCOR. When you give to UMCOR 100% of your donation goes to where designated.
