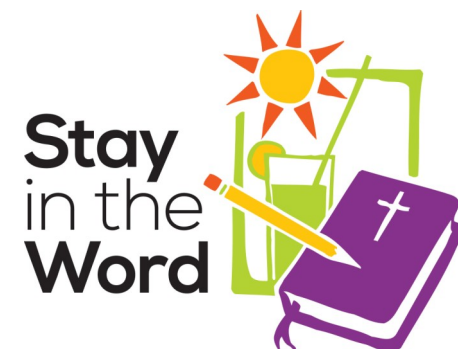

Healthcare Equipment
Recycling Organization

The Mission of HERO is to collect and redistribute donated healthcare supplies to help those in need. HERO was founded in 1996 by nurses from the local Association of Operating Room Nurses who saw a need they could potentially fulfill. Since then HERO has become a leader in the redistribution of durable medical equipment.

HERO provides cost effective supplies ranging from gauze and bandages to wheelchairs and lifts for people who need them. Each year HERO sends supplies on over 60 mission trips around the world. HERO has been on every continent but Antarctica.

Through redistribution of supplies in 2015, HERO saved over 172,000 pounds of usable medical supplies from ending up in local landfills.

The money donated to HERO by Calvary VBS students will be used to help provide a pediatric wheelchair to a child from Fargo when the need arises. If you have any items you'd like to donate to HERO (walkers, canes, crutches, bandages etc.) they can be dropped off at their offices at 5012 53rd St S, Fargo, ND 58104
