Just One Meal

On Tuesday September 27, Fraser, Ltd's Just One Meal is an opportunity to feed our young neighbors in need. Community members, businesses, churches, and civic organizations are asked to donate the cost of one meal to help feed at-risk youth and young adults experiencing homelessness.

Fraser's Stepping Stones Resource Center (one of Calvary's Mission of the Months) they saw sixteen hundred 16-20 year olds utilize their service. This fall they will also begin serving healthy community meals daily for those young people involved in their programs as well as other youth and adults in need.

They are projecting feeding up to 250 people a day. We can make a difference. Please consider skipping on meal on Tuesday September 27th and donating the amount you would have spent to Fraser. \$17.50 will provide a youth one nourishing meal daily for a week

\$35 will feed an individual healthy meals for a week
