Next week Fargo Community Trust Officer Michael Bloom will be here to worship with us. At a time when tensions are flaring between communities and law enforcement, building community trust can be an uphill battle.

"A parent will say, 'You better be good Timmy or I'll get that police officer take you away and put you in jail.' And we'd prefer if parents didn't do that," said Fargo Police Chief Dave Todd.

For years Fargo Police have been trying to show kids officers are more than just a disciplinary force. The Officers don't want to be seen as the "heavies." If there's an emergency people need to feel comfortable going up to someone in a uniform and asking for help.



The Community Trust Officers are an integral part of changing a communities perception of Law Enforcement. "Police really care about all people all the time

everywhere," says Officer Bloom.

Fargo Community Trust Officers take their job of building community trust seriously without being too serious by choosing to get the community's attention in a way they won't forget.

"If it means that a cop has to rap or we have to dunk a cop in a dunk tank which we've been doing then we're just going to make it happen to show the community we care," adds the Fargo Police Community Trust Officer.
