Craig connected with the Jail Chaplains for the first time when he was arrested for DUI. Craig grew up on a dairy farm in the Fergus Falls area, the youngest in his family. His describes his childhood as supportive and his family attended church regularly. Craig's mom died of cancer when he was in his early 20s and that was the start of his abuse of alcohol.

While Craig was able to keep a job, relationships were a challenge and he lost his marriage. Living alone Craig shares how he was afraid to go home to an empty house. God got Craig's attention while he was in the Cass County Jail.

Upon release, Craig became a resident at Project HOME, accountability housing under the umbrella of Jail Chaplains. He is growing in his relationship with Jesus and now comes home to his housemates, Joshua and Jerry. In August, Craig took the step of sharing his testimony and was baptized to publically share how God is working in his life. PTL!

Jail Chaplains takes Jesus into the Cass County Jail and walks with returning citizens as they re-enter the community. Thank you Calvary family for your partnership. Together we are making a difference for eternity!
