God Made a Way; Broken to Repurposed

A lot of people enjoy television programs about fixing up old homes or furniture and making them new, something virtually unrecognizable from what had been there previously. There is something deeply satisfying taking something that others view as unsalvageable and giving it purpose.

This past Tuesday hundreds of people filled the ballroom of the Holiday Inn and heard testimonies of people that many would have claimed were unsalvageable, unredeemable, not worth the effort.

Attendees were blessed by story after story of God's provision, not only for those who were incarcerated, but for those involved in volunteering. Time and time again we were reminded that "God made a way."

The Jail Chaplains embodies the truth of Isaiah 61
The Spirit of the Lord God is on Me, because the Lord has anointed Me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and freedom to the prisoners; to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor, and the day of our God's vengeance; to comfort all who mourn, to provide for those who mourn in Zion; to give them a crown of beauty instead of ashes festive oil instead of mourning, and splendid clothes instead of despair.

And they will be called righteous trees, planted by the Lord to glorify Him. They will rebuild the ancient ruins; they will restore the former devastations; they will renew the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.

Calvary has been a long time supporter of the Jail Chaplains, please continue to pray for those who are a part of the programs, both volunteers and those being served.
