Open Doors 65 mission is to reach people for Jesus by providing for physical and spiritual needs in a Christ-honoring way. Open Doors 65 has quietly offered hope and help in Jesus' name in downtown Fargo since 2010. {213 NP Ave, Fargo} They provide a place to get off the street and enjoy a snack, friendly conversation, and to receive limited free clothing, basic household necessities, and day-old products. Open Doors 65s' guests include the needy, homeless, refugees, and those recently released from jail. The needs are critical, and on the rise: we typically serve more than 250 households and distribute 3000 thrift store items per month. Household sizes range from single individuals to a household of 12. Open Doors 65 is a registered nonprofit organization run by volunteer staff and board of directors. Open Doors 65 is supported by individuals donors and churches, their expense is \$1500 a month.
