For the last two years, we have held our “Cookies by the Pound” sale which has been received very well. We were very thankful to receive the Christmas eve offering in 2015. With that we delivered 400 Health Kits to UMCOR plus 22 donated kits.

Our local missions are: Bible for children, books for Brides, Ronald McDonald House, Good Samaritan fund, Churches United for the Homeless, New Life Center, Fargo Food Pantry, Wesley Acres camp, supplies to the YWCA, CEF, and Hospice.

We give to the District and National UMW through Gifts in memory, Pledges to Missions, Special Recognition pins, thank offering and Call to Prayer and Self denial offerings.

We have 16 active members and 6 inactive members. We meet the second Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM, September-December and February-May. All women are welcome to join us at any time. We would be happy to have you.
