This year Calvary's Upward Sports program is reaching 435 basketball students and 16 cheerleading students. Every week each team practices once and has one game. Each practice includes a devotional time and each game has half-time devotions where the Word of God is shared and explained.

Practices are held at Calvary UMC, First Assembly of God, Kindred School, and Centennial School. Games are held on Saturdays at three venues: Calvary UMC, First Assembly of God, and Grace Lutheran School.

Thank you to all the volunteers—over 85 basketball coaches, four cheerleading coaches, 10-15 referees, concession stand helpers, hospitality and welcome people, practice night monitors, set-up and take down helpers, score keepers & time clock, announcers, people and families who are praying for each team, and our Upward Director, Mr. John Blair. Yes, it takes a village to run this ministry.

At Calvary alone, between 800 and 1,000 people come through our doors every Saturday. Please pray for our end-of-the-year celebration on March 14th at 6:00 PM.
