Mission of the Month for July

Bhutan, a Buddhist kingdom on the Himalayas’ eastern edge, is known for its monasteries, fortresses (or dzongs) and dramatic landscapes that range from subtropical plains to steep mountains and valleys. In the High Himalayas, peaks such as 7,326m Jomolhari are popular trekking destinations. Paro Taktsang monastery (also known as Tiger’s Nest) clings to cliffs above the forested Paro Valley.

Bhutan is linguistically rich with over nineteen dialects spoken in the country. The richness of the linguistic diversity can be attributed to the geographical location of the country with its high mountain passes and deep valleys. These geographical features forced the inhabitants of the country to live in isolation but also contributed to their survival.

Bhutan is one of the world’s least evangelized countries. Christian churches operate undercover and normally in people’s homes. Evangelizing there to Buddhists is illegal, which means that many do not hear the life-saving gospel of Christ. Yet, Awana Bhutan is still growing! Awana exists in Bhutan to reach kids with the incredible news of the gospel, equip leaders there with courage and proven training methods, and to change the lives of many who wonder if life can provide something more.

There are around 200,000 children in Bhutan today under the age of 15. More than 20% live in poverty and have to help their parents in managing a subsistence livelihood. Awana Bhutan offers learning through fun activities and trained leaders, and it is able to work through local churches in ways foreign organizations cannot. Since the first club began there in 2000, the gospel of Christ has shown each child in Awana that he or she is precious to God and created specially by Him!

Every week, Awana Bhutan reaches 4,158 children with the gospel in their heart language through 177 clubs. Please continue to pray for our missionary Gajendra Tamang as he disciples leaders to take the truth of Jesus to the children of Bhutan.

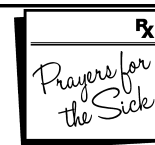
LOOKING AHEAD
