To our friends at Calvary Church —

There is nothing quite like sitting with a group of students and being the first one in years, if not ever, to tell them that they have incredible value. There is so much power in those simple words because they convey the heart of Father God. It is a joy in our hearts to be able to release these life-giving words over the students around us.

Shortly after we returned to China two months ago, the Lord began highlighting that it would be a season of “identity,” helping to restore the sense of value and identity in this land. He has been opening doors, both on the college campuses, and through Karla’s art classes, for us to make known God’s heart for each person. All of the intellectual arguments that these student have been spoon-fed for years come crumbling down when they experience the heart of God touching their soul. It’s a beautiful thing and we’re so honored to be a part of it!

The past two months have been quite full for us. We have the prayer room up and running again, with 18 hours of prayer and worship happening there every week. We are also into week 3 of both our prayer and worship internship (for college students) and Karla’s art classes (for 5-13 year-olds). Our team here is now 6 people, with another couple from the US joining us, along with 2 local sisters. It’s been great to see how God has been answering our prayers for unity and drawing many groups together in building up the house of prayer in our city.

On the home front, our kids are doing good, and we’re excited to announce that baby #4 is due the beginning of November!! God is good and we are so blessed!
