Gideons International Mission of the Month for December

Did you know? The Gideons International has legally distributed 3.7 million scriptures in 14 different provinces throughout the People’s Republic of China, even though there are no organized Gideon Camps in China. They are supplied by Gideons but distributed through various businesses in China and house churches.

Recently, the Fargo area Gideons distributed 500 sidewalk New Testaments to students at Ben Franklin Middle School and 230 on the sidewalk around Carl Ben Eielson school.

A Fargo Gideon recently returned from a Mission Trip to Cuba to help set up a meeting place for a Campus Crusade organization there. He was able to distribute 100 Spanish New Testaments there, mostly through a prison Chaplain. He also visited with a shop keeper who had just been reading a worn Gideon New Testament and said he received it some time ago and he was now a saved man.

A Gideon from Dallas, Texas spoke at a church consisting mostly of refugees from Myanmar. Attendance was down to one-half that day and he wasn’t expecting much in the Gideon offering, which was the third offering of the service. To his surprise the offering totaled \$779.00 The Gideon confided, “The Lord has been teaching me not to depend on my expectations, and I certainly learned my lesson that day.” Out God is so much greater than all of our expectations. Praise the Lord we can depend on Him.
