1. Why do we struggle?
Natural Man - (1 Cor 2:14) - *the person who does not know Christ.*

Spiritual Man - (1 Cor 2:15-16) - *"has the mind of Christ". Sees life from a heavenly perspective.*

Carnal Man - (1 Cor 3:1-6) - *The immature Christian. The one who lives on a childhood level because they will not feed on the Word and grow.*
2. Pride goes before a fall. Proverbs 16:18
The World says we can do anything and be anyone.
The Bible says we are Saved By Grace. We cannot do this on our own.
A humble person is not one who thinks little of themselves, hangs their head and says I'm nothing.
