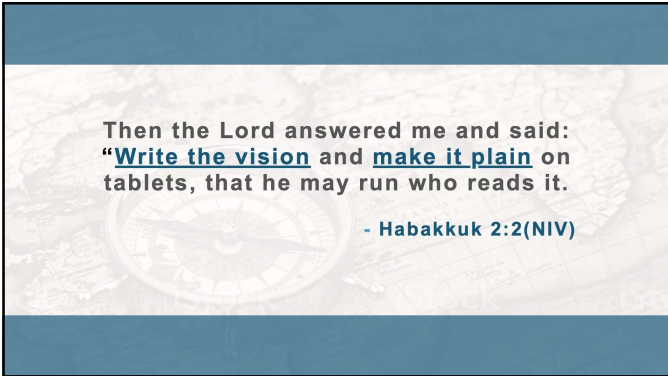





Vision 2023 – All-In Worship A Church for Everyone (Part 2)
Habakkuk 2:2-3, Revelation 4:8-11


1. What do you imagine when you hear the phrase, "A Church for Everyone"?






Building an All-In Culture

3. **All-In Community**




ALL-IN WORSHIP

3. **Authority of Scripture and a Culture of Prayer as essential keys to spiritual formation.**




ALL-IN WORSHIP

5. **Powerful, spirit-filled transformational Sunday gatherings.**





KEYS TO DEVELOP ALL-IN WORSHIP CULTURE

1. Right Motivation (In view of God's mercy)
2. Right Attitude (Offer your bodies)
3. Right Posture (Living sacrifice)
4. Right Destination (Holy and pleasing) -- Isaiah 53:10



RIGHT MOTIVATION is formed by:

1. Proper view of God's mercy — Romans 11:30-32
2. Determined by Jesus' words, "I desire mercy, not sacrifice." — Matthew 9:9-13


RIGHT ATTITUDE is formed by:

- 1. Full diet of the Word (All of It)**
- 2. Passion for, and culture of, PRAYER**
- 3. Release and full operation of spiritual gifts**
- 4. Philippians 2 Humility**

RIGHT POSTURE (Living Sacrifice)


- 1. Living in a way that exhibits the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus.**
- 2. In other words, living as a picture of baptism or communion. Also known as living sacramentally.**
- 3. Philippians 2, Romans 5:8**

Our Sunday morning worship experiences is a direct reflection of how our Monday through Saturday living.




RIGHT DESTINATION (Holy and Pleasing)
