
TITLE: Vision 2023 (Part 4) All-In Community SCRIPTURE: Habakkuk 2:2-3; Acts 2:42-47

4. How do we create a church for everyone and every ONE?









> Then ask yourself, how well would I treat them if they did come?


Deitrick Bonhoeffer on FELLOWSHIP

The final break-through to fellowship does not occur, because, though they have fellowship with one another as believers and as devout people, they do not have fellowship as the undevout, as sinners. The pious fellowship permits no one to be a sinner. So everybody must conceal his sin from himself and from the fellowship. We dare not be sinners.

Deitrick Bonhoeffer on FELLOWSHIP


Many Christians are unthinkably horrified when a real sinner is suddenly discovered among the righteous. So we remain alone with our sin, living in lies and hypocrisy.

Apostle's Teaching:

With Only — likely a legalistic church with no grace and empathy for the lost.

Fellowship:

Without — likely an unfriendly or corporate church where you are just a number.

With Only — likely a community or social group.

The Breaking of Bread (communion)

Without — likely lacking spiritual formation and regular visible ritual that returns you to the foot of the cross.

With Only — lives for the tradition of sacrament instead of living sacramentally.

Prayer:

Without — likely a church with no power.

With Only — You have an inward-focused, highly mystical group that may appear like a cult
