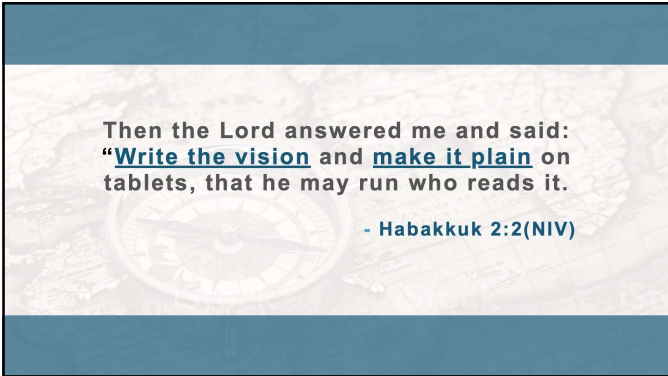




DISCUSSION QUESTIONS


Building an All-In Culture

- **Shared leadership – Every member a minister (priesthood of all believers)**

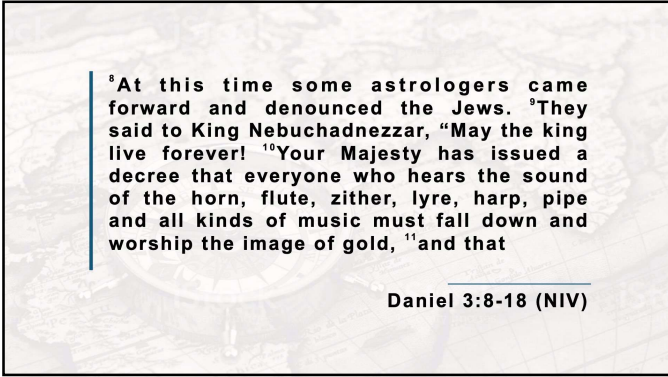


Values of All-In Leadership

- **Missional (On Mission) mindset**

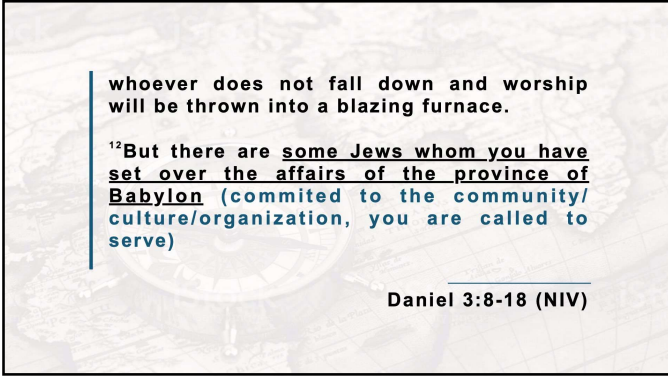

—Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego—who pay no attention to you, Your Majesty. They neither serve your gods nor worship the image of gold you have set up (committed to God).”

¹³Furious with rage, Nebuchadnezzar summoned Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego. So these men were brought before the king, ¹⁴and Nebuchadnezzar said to them, “Is it true, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, that you do not serve my gods or worship the image of gold I have set up? ¹⁵Now when you hear the sound of the horn,

flute, zither, lyre, harp, pipe and all kinds of music, if you are ready to fall down and worship the image I made, very good. But if you do not worship it, you will be thrown immediately into a blazing furnace. Then what god will be able to rescue you from my hand?”

to him, "King Nebuchadnezzar, we do not need to defend ourselves before you in this matter (**maturity**). ¹⁷If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and he will deliver us from Your Majesty's hand.

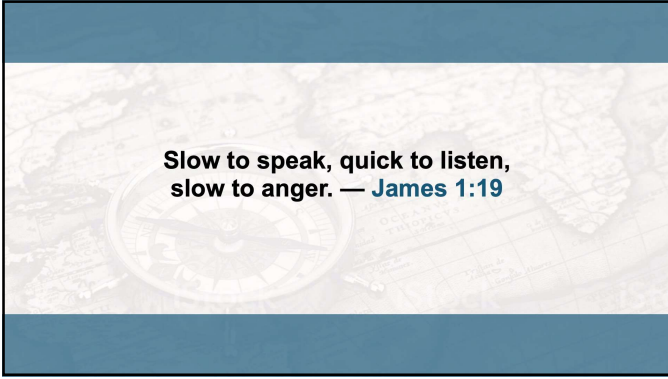

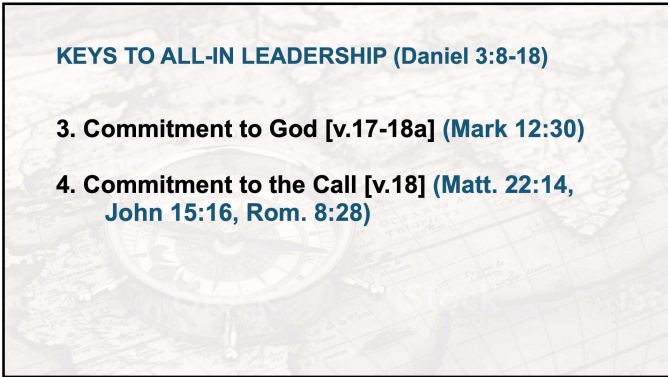

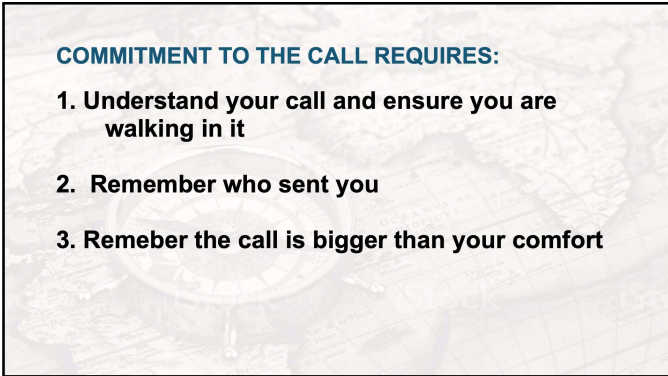

- 2. Maturity / Berean mindset [v.16] (Acts 17:10-12; James 1:19)**





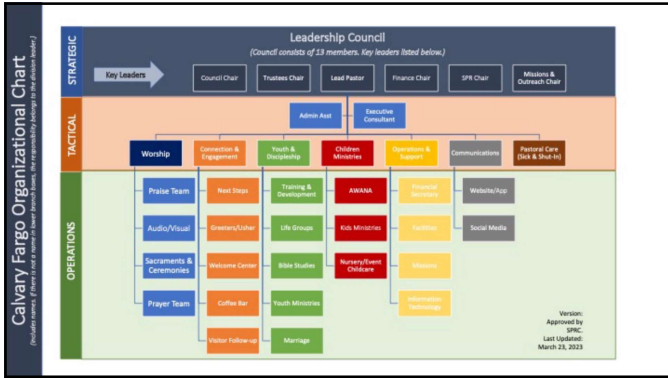


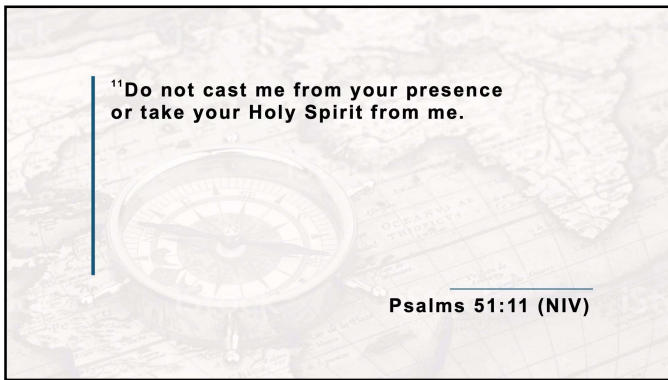
ANATOMY OF A CALL

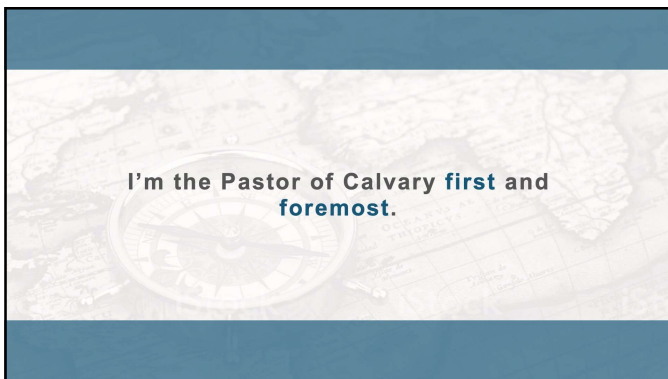
- 1. Spiritual gift - What is your spiritual gift/DNA?**
